Expands list of eligible providers who can offer telehealth, including mental health providers



2.

Ensures patients can receive telehealth care in any location

3.

Expands coverage for additional services, like remote patient monitoring



4.

Requires health insurers and Medicaid to cover telemonitoring services for their enrollees if certain requirements are met

Telehealth nurses monitor patient remotely, engage and assess the patient, initiate audio-video calls, intervene and document care
